- 4. ATSA is actively seeking to recruit diverse perspectives and representation to bring various points of view into decision making and to inform organizational strategic directions. Describe the diverse perspectives and experiences you would bring to this role.
- 5. Give an example of a time you worked collaboratively to achieve a goal in a leadership role.
